- Letter of motivation (anonymized)
- CV (anonymized)
- Transcript of academic records, including grades
- Perception (essay/video) regarding this year's call (anonymized)
- in case of an initiative application: Letter of recommendation

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I apply if I will go **abroad** during the scholarship?
A: **Yes.**

Q: Is a **letter of recommendation** required?
A: Only if you apply initially.

Q: How large is a **group**?
A: Usually **5 to 8** people.

Q: How many people will be **accepted**?
A: About **40-50 people**.

Q: How much **time** do we have to invest?
A: **6-8 hours** per week.

Q: Is TUMJA a **paid** scholarship?
A: **No.**
