- Transparency of the criteria for career advancement

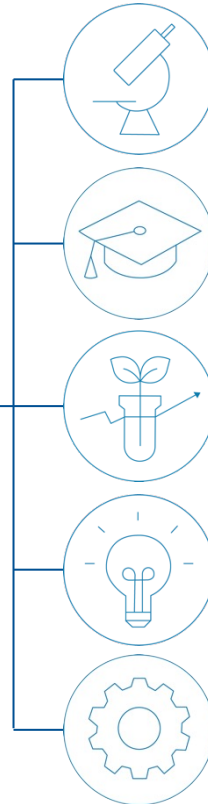
Organizational Development

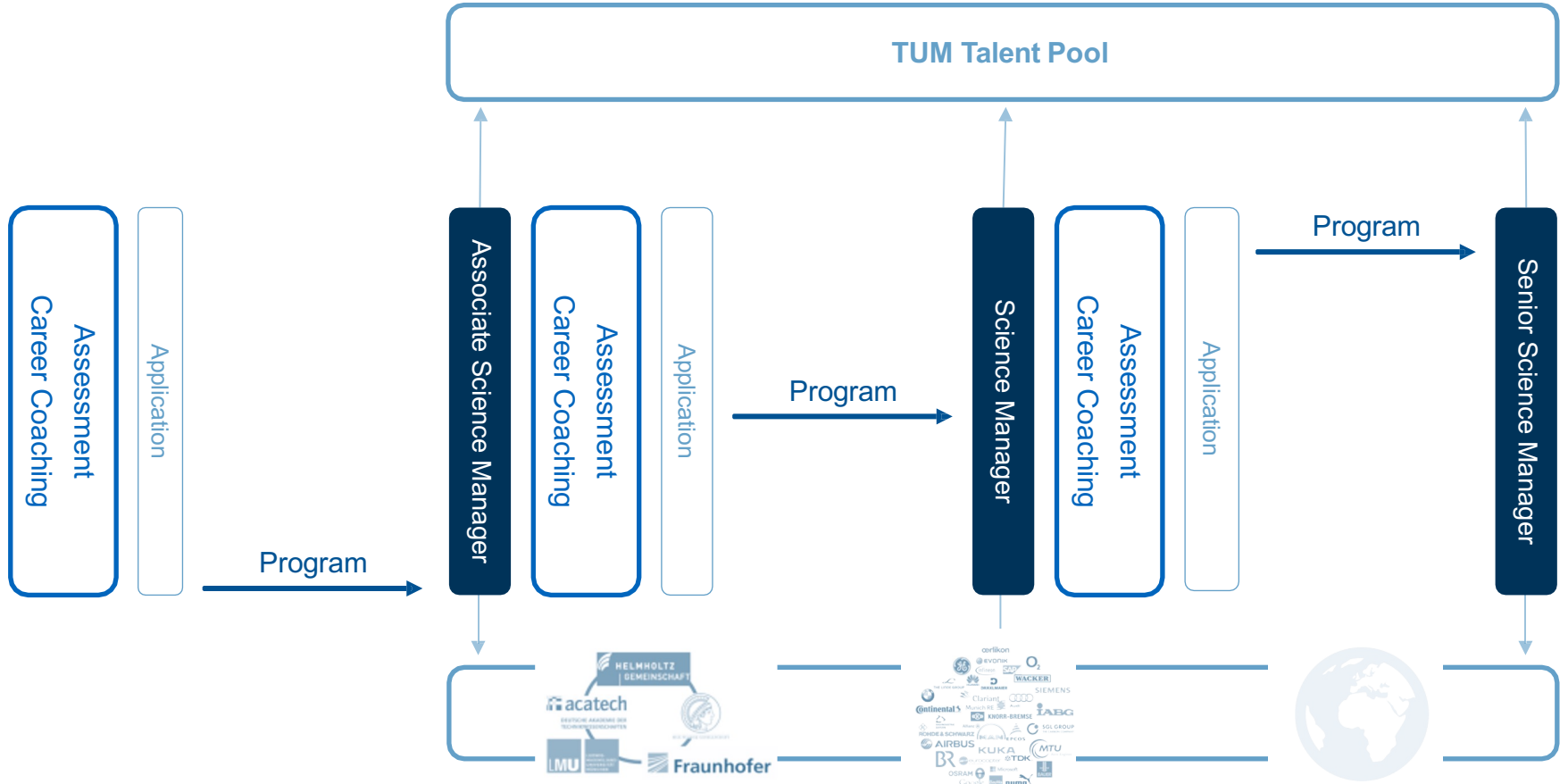
