When does the program start? How long does it take?

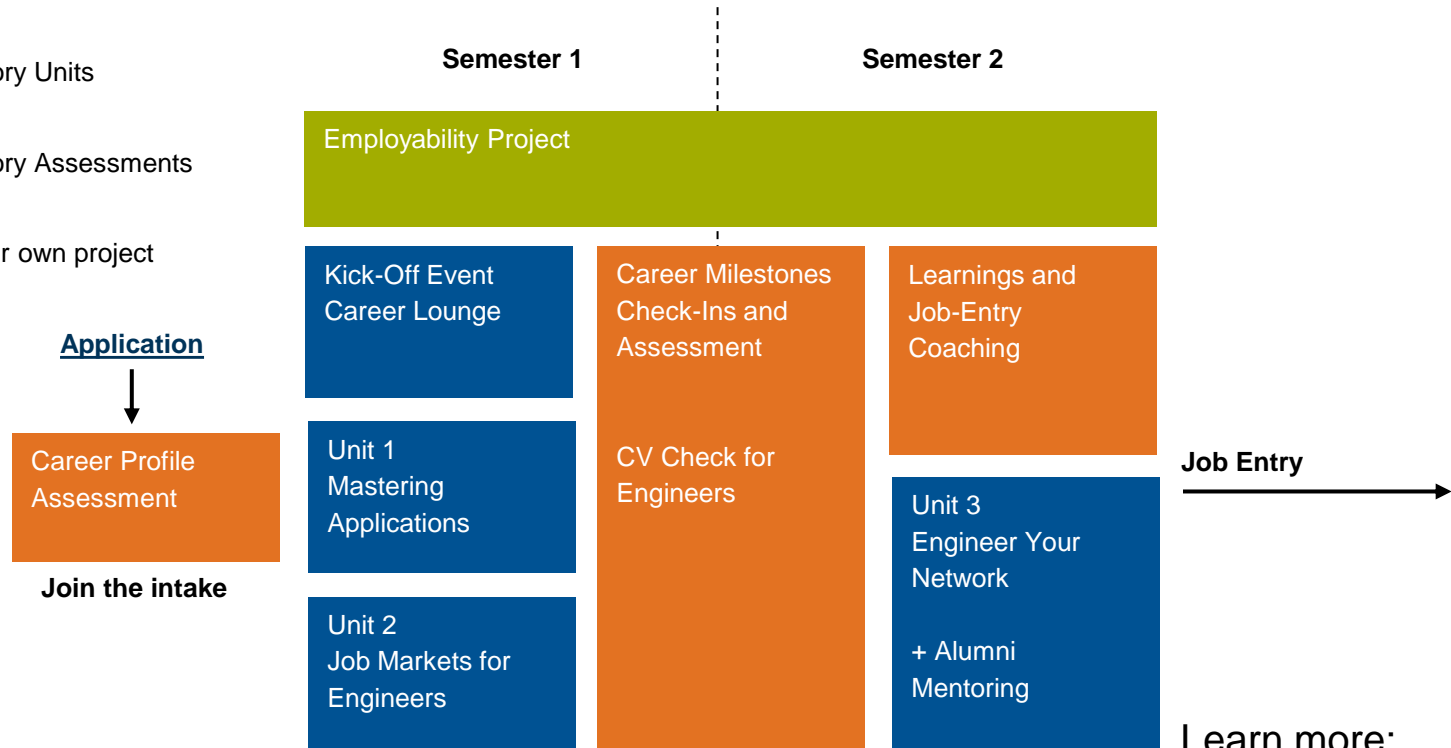
Individual assessment before start of lectures, activities start in the winter semester. The program spans over two semesters.
